Jesus is Born Luke 2:1-7

Jesus is the best gift.

Key Question

How do we know God loves us?

Bottom Line

God gave us Jesus.

Memory Verse

God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son. John 3:16 GNT

Inclusive Pro Tips



Loud sounds, bright lights, and large groups can be overwhelming or overstimulating for some children. To create a more inclusive large group experience, consider offering adaptive tools like noise-canceling headphones, sunglasses, sensory-friendly items, or access to modified spaces.

Bible Study Prayer

1 Worship

LEADER: "Hi, friends! I am SO happy to see you today! My name is **[your name]**, and I have a question for you.

"If you could give someone a really great gift, what would it be? (*Pause.*) Would you give someone a really fun toy car? Everybody, say: (*pretend to tap a car horn*) 'Beep-beep! (*pretend to turn a steering wheel*) Vroooom!"

CHILDREN and LEADER: (pretend to tap a car horn) "Beepbeep! (pretend to turn a steering wheel) Vroooom!"

LEADER: "Or what about a puppy—woof, woof! Or a cat—meow! Can you bark or meow with me?

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Woof-woof! Meow! Woof-woof! Meow!"

LEADER: "Those would be really great gifts, but I know someone who has already given you the best gift ever. *(Point up.)* God gave you Jesus. And we celebrate Jesus' birthday at Christmas. So, let's stand up and celebrate Jesus!

→ Lead children in singing "Happy Birthday Jesus."

"Great singing, friends! Now let's learn some of God's words from the Bible. (Open hands like a book.) Are you ready? Watch me say the words from the Bible and do the motions, and then you can do them with me!

→ Note: A video of the Memory Verse Motions is available in the Prelude folder and on Pinterest.

"God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son," (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.)

"Can you do that with me?

→ Lead children to say the Memory Verse with Hand Motions once or twice.

"Great job, friends! Let's sing one more song together.

→ Lead children in singing "It's a Holy Night."

Bible Study Prayer

"Thanks for celebrating Jesus with me! [Transition] And now it's time to turn around (spin around) ... sit down (sit down) ... shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) ... so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

② Bible Story

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm *[your name]*, and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible.

→ Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"Today's true story from the Bible is found in the book of Luke, and it begins with Mary and Joseph.

SLIDE → Story Image W2 01

"Mary and Joseph loved God. They were part of God's people. One day, Mary and Joseph had to go to a town called Bethlehem, but they had to travel a LONG way to get there. And Mary was going to have a baby!

SLIDE → Story Image W2 02

"Mary and Joseph probably walked all the way to Bethlehem. Or maybe Mary rode on an animal—like a donkey!

"Once Mary and Joseph got to Bethlehem, they stayed in a place that had a manger. A manger is a box that animals eat out of. So, that means Mary and Joseph stayed in a place that might have had some animals.

SLIDE → Story Image W2 03

"Look at this picture. Do you see any animals?

→ Point to the chicken in the Story Image.

"I see a chicken. Can you cluck like a chicken?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Cluck, cluck, cluck. Cluck, cluck, cluck."

Bible Study Prayer

LEADER: "Do you see a donkey?

→ Point to the donkey in the Story Image.

"There it is. Can you hee-haw like a donkey?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Hee-haw. Hee-haw. Hee-haw."

LEADER: "I also see a sheep.

> Point to the sheep in the Story Image.

"Can you baa like a sheep?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Baa. Baa. Baa."

LEADER: "Wow! You are so good at making animal sounds.

"Mary and Joseph didn't stay some place fancy, but that didn't matter. God gave us something very special there. A very special baby was born there, and that baby was God's Son, Jesus!

"Jesus was born! Everyone, say "Happy Birthday, Jesus!"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Happy Birthday, Jesus!"

LEADER: "Let's pretend we're holding baby Jesus.

→ Rock arms like you're holding a baby.

"The Bible teaches us that:

"Mary took baby Jesus in her arms, wrapped Him in strips of cloth, and laid Him in a manger. (Luke 2:7)

"Wow! Jesus is the best gift ever because He shows us how much God loves us. God loves us SO much that [Bottom Line] God gave us Jesus. Tell me: How do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: [Bottom Line] "God gave us Jesus!"

LEADER: "Yes, [Bottom Line] God gave us Jesus.

Pick up and close Bible.

Transition → "Our story time is over, but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

3 Prayer

LEADER: "Dear God, you gave us the best gift ever. You gave us Jesus! Thank you for loving us so much that you gave us Your Son. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen."

Transition → "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!" Lead small group to the first activity.
