How do we know God loves us?

Bottom Line

God gave us Jesus.

Memory Verse

God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son. John 3:16 GNT

Inclusive Pro Tips



Loud sounds, bright lights, and large groups can be overwhelming or overstimulating for some children. To create a more inclusive large group experience, consider offering adaptive tools like noise-canceling headphones, sunglasses, sensory-friendly items, or access to modified spaces.

Bible Study Prayer

1 Worship

LEADER: "Hi, friends! My name is *[your name]*, and I am so happy to see you today.

"Did you know that God made every single person in this room? He did! And God loves you, and **[Basic Truth]** God loves me. God loves all of us! And God has given us so many good things ... like beautiful sunshine! Can you make a sun?

→ Hold arms in a circle overhead.

"Look at all those beautiful suns! Let's tell God thank you for the sun. Ready?

→ Do the ASL sign for "Thank you": Move flat hand forward from chin.

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Thank you, God!"

LEADER: "What else has God given us ... can you think of any food that God has given us? *(Listen.)* Like yummy blueberries or big red apples? Let's pretend to take a bite out of an apple.

→ Pretend to take a bite out of an apple.

"Mmmm, so yummy! Let's tell God thank you for the food He gives us. Ready?

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Thank you, God!"

LEADER: "God is SO good, He even gave us His Son Jesus! Let's tell God thank you for giving us Jesus. Ready?

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Thank you, God!"

LEADER: "Now let's stand up and celebrate our God and how He gave us Jesus.

→ Lead children in singing "Happy Birthday Jesus."

"Great singing, friends! Now let's learn some of God's words from the Bible. (*Open hands like a book.*) Are you ready? Watch me say the words from the Bible and do the motions, and then you can do them with me!

Bible Study Prayer

→ Note: A video of the Memory Verse Motions is available in the Prelude folder and on Pinterest.

"God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son," (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.)

"Can you do that with me?

→ Lead children to say the Memory Verse with Hand Motions once or twice.

"Great job, friends! Let's sing one more song about the night Jesus was born.

→ Lead children in singing "It's a Holy Night."

"Thanks for celebrating God with me! [Transition] And now it's time to turn around (spin around) ... sit down (sit down) ... shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands) ... so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

② Bible Story

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm *[your name]*, and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible. It is in the book of Luke.

→ Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"The true story of Christmas begins with God's love for us.

SLIDE → Story Image W1 01

"Do you know that God loves you? He does! Give yourself a big hug!

→ Hug yourself.

"God loved you even before you were born! And because God loves you and God loves me SO much, God gave us Jesus to be our friend forever!

Bible Study Prayer

"It all started a long time ago when God sent a special message to a young woman named Mary.

"Now, how do you think God sent this special message to Mary? Do you think God sent the special message with a letter in the mail?

→ Shake your head 'no.'

"No. Do you think God sent the special message with a video call?

→ Shake your head 'no.'

"No! God sent the message in an even more amazing way. God sent an angel!

SLIDE → Story Image W1 03

"Whoa! Look at Mary's face. How do you think Mary felt when she saw the angel? Mary was afraid.

"Everyone, show me your afraid face.

→ Make an afraid face.

"Yes, Mary was afraid!

"But the angel said, "Do not be afraid, Mary." (Luke 1:30 NIV)

"Can you say that with me?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Do not be afraid, Mary."

LEADER: "The angel had a very special message to tell Mary, and it was GREAT news!

SLIDE → Story Image W1 04

"The angel told Mary that she was going to have a baby. The angel said: "The baby will be God's Son, and you will call him Jesus."

"That was great news!

Bible Study Prayer

"God loves us so much He gave us His Son Jesus. How do we know God loves us?"

CHILDREN and LEADER: [Bottom Line] "God gave us Jesus!"

LEADER: "Yes, [Bottom Line] God gave us Jesus, and that is what we celebrate at Christmas. [Bottom Line] God gave us Jesus.

→ Pick up and close Bible.

Transition →"Our story time is over, but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

3 Prayer

LEADER: "Dear God, thank you for giving us Your Son, Jesus. Help us to celebrate Jesus every day. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

Transition → "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!" Lead small group to the first activity.
